

**Cardinal Creek Community Association Snowmobile Petition**  
**City of Ottawa and Ottawa Police Services**

The purpose of this petition is four-fold:

- 1) **To move the groomed Carleton Regional Snowmobile Trail to the east side of Cardinal Creek (rural area) in 2007;**
- 2) **To seek increased police enforcement of snowmobilers driving in the urban area, along the hydro lines, in close proximity to the East Village subdivision, and on the Springridge pedestrian only walking path in winter 2006-07;**
- 3) **To request that the City of Ottawa develop a snowmobile trailer area in the rural area only, within close proximity of the groomed snowmobile trails in 2007; and**
- 4) **To establish six gated entrances into the Springridge pedestrian only walking pathway in 2006.**

The Cardinal Creek Community Association (CCCA), on behalf of the residents living within our boundaries, are hereby requesting the City of Ottawa and the Ottawa Police Services take the required action to ensure that public safety is enhanced and to allow home owners the quiet enjoyment of their property.

Furthermore, installation of appropriate gating at the entrances to the Springridge pedestrian pathway is now required to prevent snowmobiles, four wheelers, and work trucks from accessing this pedestrian pathway.

Residents are now requesting that such gates be installed at the following locations, with specific details of the location and the form of the gates to be provided to the community by the City of Ottawa under consultation in fall 2006.

1. At the entrance to the walking path just to the rear of the Springridge Trail Head Park (behind house on corner of Heatherstone/Springridge).
2. At the rear of pathway link on the northwest corner (middle) of Heatherstone.
3. At the pathway on the east side access to the drainage facility behind Heatherstone, both along the rear of pathway link and on top of the hill.
4. At the pathway entrance to the storm water management facility off of Springridge between Heatherstone and Caprihani Way.
5. a) At the rear of pathway link at the southern end of the development where Park 18b is situated (such that access to Park 18B from/to Bergamot Street is restricted) and b) to restrict access to/from Park 18B from/to the ravine pathway.
6. At the rear of pathway link on Caprihani Way, adjacent to rear yard fences.
